 - a) Make sure you are not listed as something you are not (e.g. editor of a predatory journal)
- 2) Search name in Dimensions or Google Scholar
 - a) Subscribe to alerts for your name Dimensions, Scopus or Web of Science
 - b) Citation alerts are your results being misrepresented?
- 3) Be aware of scams and predatory publishers
 - a) Retraction watch follows paper retractions
 - b) Pubpeer -platform for postpublication review
